Picking up after themselves.



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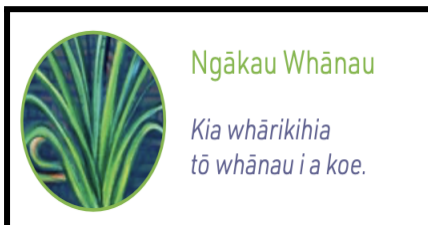
Ngākau Manaaki

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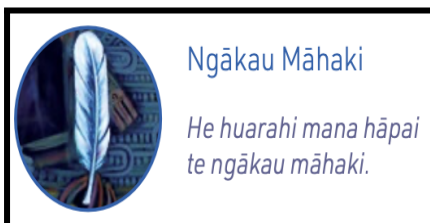
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Ngākau Whānau - Kia whārikihia tō whānau i a koe
